VISITORS COMMENTS

Joe Kelly provided information about D P & L's Economic Development Fund. He explained that D P & L's goal and commitment was to provide a \$6 million investment from 20141-2016 to partner with area business, organizations and communities to support marketing West Central Ohio to attract new investment in the region, retention of existing business by helping them to remain competitive in the region and the creation of jobs and a job-ready workforce. DP & L will provide funds for infrastructure grants, regional economic development grants, site certification, and a small business deposit loan fund.

Chief Wallace thanked those that helped to judge the Halloween costume contest. He provided information about the annual Lunch with Santa scheduled for December 13^{th from} 11:30 a.m. until 2 p.m.

LAW DIRECTOR COMMENTS

Mayor Morneault suggested that the Personnel Committee meet and discuss the employee wages and insurance benefits.

VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR REPORT:

Mr. Sears reported that leaf pickup was ongoing and reminded everyone that the Village offices would be closed in observance of Veterans Day. He provided some information about the first week of the feral cat program.

FISCAL OFFICER REPORT

Ms. Schenck reported that the Village had received a 60% refund from the Bureau of Workman's Compensation and that she had prepared a proclamation for the Izor's retirement. She has been working with Ms. Dill and Mr. Sears to prepare the final draft of the 2015 budget.

Mayor Morneault read Ordinance No. O2014-05, an ordinance to raise the refuse rate paid by the Village of Farmersville's residents for trash removal service for the first time.
