- Mr. Sears was advised to not stripe the side of Hemple for pedestrians to walk. That type of stripe is for bicycles not pedestrians. Mr. Sears further stated that he is very concerned about residents who walk on Hemple Rd. being hit by a car and the village could have prevented this from happening if the sidewalks were left in the plans as proposed.
- Mr. Sears is still pursuing the Clean Ohio Grant for a "walk path" from Hemple Rd. to Walnut St.
