

VILLAGE OF FARMERSVILLE
Minutes of Village Council Meeting
May 10, 2021

On Monday, May 10, 2021, the Farmersville Village Council met in regular session via Zoom/in person in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Mayor Nick Lamb called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and followed by a roll call.

FIRE ASSOCIATION COMMENTS:

Chief Erisman announced that an outdoor family movie night event will take place sometime this summer with the date TBD. The fire department will sell popcorn, pop and candy bars.

LAW DIRECTOR COMMENTS:

Ms. Knight is finalizing the contract for the Community Garden partnership. Ms. Knight looked through the JEDD contract and believes it looks fine as is.

VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR REPORT:

Village Administrator Shell provided the following report:

Streets

- Kramer Engineering working on plans for final phase of Center St.
- Anticipate project going out to bid towards the end of May.

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Water

- Water Tower completed except painting of concrete footer (weather)
- Submitted CCR to Ohio EPA for review
- 2 payouts to American Suncraft. There will be one more after footer is painted.

Wastewater

- Repaired chlorine leak at wastewater plant
- Started disinfection May 1st of effluent water

Park/Pool

- Shamrock pools in for leak detection
 - Return lines tested ok
 - Ran camera down drain lines ok
 - Skimmer lines failed due to wrong winterization plugs for testing
 - Lights were removed and the conduit holes were caulked
 - Recommended we fill pool and monitor
- Pool is filling and chemicals will arrive 5/11/21
- Dumpster moved west side of front lot (park board)
- 2 additional porta- johns brought in (park board)

Zoning

- After computers were updated Zone Pro is no longer on Administrator computer

General

- Community garden path cut in
- FABAs asked where the new voting polls
- Dumpster moved west side of front lot (park board) requested
- 2 additional porta-jons brought in (park board) requested
- Mel ordered dumpster for June
- Community garage sale advertising??
- 36 month increase @ a rate of 3% each year to cover refuse services
- Working with FABAs on hometown hero banners

Derek Shell announced that the Community Pool is opening.

Mr. Holderman suggested a working session with Jackson Twp. Trustees to discuss the joint park. 7/12 worked for all Council Members.


