Mr. Shell sought Council for approval to spend an additional \$8,700 to cover the cost of engineering plans for upgrading the water main on Apple Dive. The only two water mains left to be upgraded in the Village are on Apple Drive and California Street. He will hire Kramer Engineering for the design services because they are the engineer of record for the upcoming Center Street road project. If we pay Kramer for the design now, we have the option to upgrade the water main during the Center Street project or in the future (most likely 2022) when we upgrade California Street. The estimated cost for the water main work is \$50,000 - \$60,000. We will not have exact costs until the Center Street project goes out for bid with the Apple Street water main project attached as a voluntary adder.

At 5:41 pm Mr. Depew moved, Mrs. Hadley seconded to approve Derek to hire Kramer Engineering for \$8,700 to provide engineering design services associated with replacing the water main on Apple Drive.
