Minutes of Village Special Council Meeting

Monday, September 9th, 2024

On Monday September 9th 2024, The Farmersville Village Council met in a special meeting, Mayor Nick Lamb called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and followed by roll call.

The purpose of the Special Meeting is to discuss the Farmersville/Jackson Township Joint Recreation Park. Council members met with Jackson Township Trustees.

POOL DISCUSSION:

Mayor Lamb reported that Tom Sears, Brian Smith, Mr. Shell and Trustee Hodson visited the Eaton City pool recently. Eaton City Pool was designed by Astro Pool Company. Astro Pool Company can design a new pool for the park based off a given amount. Astro Pool would design the pool and present the design to the Village of Farmersville and Jackson Township. Ms. Kozarec reported the pool fund balance is approximately \$500,000 and the park fund is approximately \$64,000. The pool levy is up for renewal in 2026. It was suggested the levy be placed as a replacement levy, which will generate more funds. Ms. Hamaker reported 76 passes were sold for the 2024 season, 47 resident and 25 non-resident. There was discussion about the pool not being open during regular business hours. Trustee Moyer stated the pool has staffing issues. Mayor Lamb states the staffing needs to be reorganized before a pool upgrade occurs. There was discussion about including a unique attraction at the pool to attract patrons. For example, a rock-climbing wall. Astro Pool Company will meet with the park committee Wednesday, September 18, 2024, at the pool to evaluate current pool and need for an upgrade. The park committee will gather information from Astro Pool Company and present the information to the community before the pool level comes up for renewal. Trustee Hodson will find out a timeframe for the pool upgrade from Astro Pool Company.

PARK DISCUSSION:


There was discussion to hire a company to create a master plan for the park. Mayor Lamb will find contacts for companies to create a plan. The park committee can compile the data

and report to the Trustees and Councilmembers. Ms. Hamaker reports the porta potties have been installed at the park. Spartan Roofing were hired to improve the shelters at the park. Mr. Mckinney is creating a new sign for the recycle center. Mayor Lamb suggests upgrading the camera system at the park.


