

**VILLAGE OF FARMERSVILLE**  
**Minutes of Special Council Meeting**  
**Monday, February 9<sup>th</sup>, 2026**

On Monday, February 9<sup>th</sup>, 2026, The Farmersville Council and Jackson Township Trustees met for a special joint meeting. Mayor Nick Lamb and Trustee President Mike Moyer called the meeting to order at 6:30pm and followed by roll call.

**DISCUSSION:** Mayor Lamb announced the purpose of the special meeting is to discuss the Joint Farmersville/Jackson Township Park and how to move forward and manage the park together.

Trustee Hodson suggested reinstatement of the park board. The park board would consist of 3 Jackson Township residents and 2 Village residents. He suggests hiring a park manager to oversee all operations at the park. Mayor Lamb suggests the Park Board should determine pay and hours for the park manager. The original park board by-laws need to be evaluated and updated as needed. Mr. Shell will send the by-laws to each entity to review. Each entity needs to vote to reinstate the park board. Jackson Township Trustees and Farmersville Council agreed to hold a special meeting at 6:30pm on March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2026.

Mr. Shell reports State Rep, Rodney Creech informed him there up-to \$200,000 in state grant funds available for playground equipment. Mr. Shell reports he will collect quotes for playground equipment and submit for the grant.

Mayor Lamb reports The Miami University Report for the park has been completed and will be uploaded to the Village website and encourages community input.

All formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of resolutions and/or motions passed at this meeting were adopted in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with the law, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

At 6:56pm, Mr. Holderman moved, Mr. Cunningham seconded to adjourn the meeting. Roll Call: Mr. Cunningham; yes, Mr. Holderman; yes, Mr. Craig; yes, Mr. Smith; yes. MOTION PASSED.
