Minutes of Special Council Meeting

Monday March 9th, 2026

On Monday, March 9th, 2026. The Farmersville Council and Jackson Township Trustees met for a special joint meeting. Mayor Nick Lamb and Trustee President Mike Moyer called the meeting to order at 6:30pm and followed by roll call.

Mayor Lamb announced the purpose of the joint meeting is to consider reinstating the park board. Trustee Hodson announced he spoke with Jackson Township's attorney about reinstating the park board. Trustee Hodson reports Jackson Township will appoint 5 members to the park board, 3 township residents and 2 village residents. Trustee Hodson reports a new resolution needs to be established to create the park board. Trustee Hodson recommends hiring Mr. Shell as the park manager to oversee park and pool operations. Mayor Lamb suggests a salary of \$1000.00 a month for the park manager. The park manager salary will be paid from the park fund. Trustee Hodson agreed. Mayor Lamb suggested reviewing by-laws via email and plan to discuss by-laws in a public meeting.

Trustee Moyer reports 60 applications have been received for lifeguards and concession workers. The Germantown employee manual needs to be reviewed and adopted by the park since the employees will be working at both Germantown pool and Farmersville/Jackson Township pool. The pay will be the same at both locations. All communication with pool manager Devin Stoutenborough will go through, Mr. Shell.

Trustees voted and agreed to hire Derek Shell as Park Manager for \$1000.00 per month.

Mr. Holderman moved. Mr. Cunningham seconded to hire Mr. Shell as Park Manager for \$1000.00 per month. Roll Call: Mr. Cunningham; yes, Mr. Holderman; yes, Ms. Lohn; yes, Mr. Morneault; yes, Mr. Smith; yes. MOTION PASSED.

Mr. Shell and Mr. Pohl reports they will work together to have the pool operational by opening day.


Mayor Lamb and Trustee Hodson reports they would like to receive community input about a park/pool levy for the 2026 November ballot. Mayor Lamb reports concern on long-term employment for the pool. Trustee Hodson suggests adding a splash pad to the park. A splash pad would be a service to township and village residents because there would be no charge to use the splash pad. Mr. Shell suggested having a community meeting at the pool, so residents can see the condition of the pool. There will be two meetings, April 20th and May 19th, both at 6:00pm. The meeting will start at the community center.

The Jackson Township Trustees voted to adjourn the meeting.


